- 6. Studying the process of interaction between society and politics in contemporary India-Caste, religion & gender.
- 7. Examining the role of Political parties in Indian Democracy.
- 8. Evaluating the Electoral Process in India with focus on the Election Commission: Composition, Functions and Role.
