M.Sc. PART-I ADMISSION 2020-21

1. M.Sc. Analytical Chemistry

i No. of Seats 20

Eligibility: B.Sc. (Three years integrated programme) in Chemistry of the University of Mumbai or has passed an Examination of another University recognized as equivalent thereto.

2. M.Sc. Organic Chemistry

i No. of Seats 20

Eligibility: B.Sc. (Three years integrated programme) in Chemistry of the University of Mumbai or has passed an Examination of another University recognized as equivalent thereto.

3. M.Sc. - Chemistry by Research

Organic Chemistry / Inorganic Chemistry / Physical Chemistry

i No. of Seats: 2 per programme

Eligibility: B.Sc. (Three years integrated programme) in Chemistry of the University of Mumbai or has passed an Examination of another University recognized as equivalent thereto.

4. M.Sc. Microbiology

i No. of Seats 10

Eligibility: B.Sc. (Three years integrated programme) in Microbiology of the University of Mumbai or has passed an Examination of another University recognized as equivalent thereto.

5. M.Sc. Biotechnology

i No. of Seats 20

Eligibility: The B.Sc. (Three years integrated programme) of the University of Mumbai or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto with the major subject Biotechnology.

OR

With three units in Biotechnology at T.Y.B.Sc. in combination with three units of any other major subject at the T.Y.B.Sc.

6. M.Sc. Computer Science

i No. of Seats 20

Eligibility: B.Sc. degree programme of University of Mumbai or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto with the following combination of subjects -

The B.Sc. (Computer Science) / B.C.S. / B.Sc. (Information Technology) degree programme.

OR

The B.Sc. with Physics as a major subject and Mathematics as an ancillary subject.

OR

The B.Sc. (Mathematics) degree programme.

OR

The B.Sc. with Statistics as a major subject and Mathematics as an ancillary subject.

OR

The Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.) degree programme.

7. M.Sc. Information Technology

i No. of Seats 20

Eligibility: B.Sc. degree programme of University of Mumbai or any other University recognized as equivalent thereto with the following combination of subjects -

The B.Sc. (Computer Science) / B.C.S. / B.Sc. (Information Technology) degree programme.

OR

The B.Sc. (Mathematics) degree programme.

OR

The B.Sc. (Physics) degree programme.

OR

The B.Sc. (Statistics) degree programme.

OR

The B.Sc. (Electronics) degree programme.

OR

The Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.) degree programme.

University Pre-Registration Form

i University Pre-Registration Form is the mandatory document required for confirmation of admission. Visit university website www.mum.digitaluniversity.ac for the purpose. In case the University has not commenced the Pre-Registration process then students should undertake to submit the pre-registration form to the college office immediately after the Pre-Registration process begins, without which the admission will not be confirmed.

For students from other Universities

i Students from other Universities should submit an undertaking at the time of admission regarding compliance of eligibility criteria as laid down by the University of Mumbai. The prescribed undertaking form is given in Annexure-1 hereunder. (The application for provisional statement of eligibility along with the supporting documents are to be submitted in the college office after the admission is confirmed and as per the notice which will be displayed separately on the college website).

Grant of admission

i The admission will be granted based on marks obtained in T.Y.B. Sc examination in SEM V and SEM VI (Excluding Applied Component).

Students who have passed Semester VI but not yet got their Semester VI marksheet can also apply, however, their admission will be provisional.

Students are required to fill the CGPA of Previous semesters i.e. Semester I, II, III & IV in the admission form too.

Admissions would be granted on the basis of merit and abiding the set norms by University of Mumbai / State Government as may be applicable to the institution with autonomous status.

The admission will be confirmed only after the verification of documents by the college authority and payment of fee by the student.
