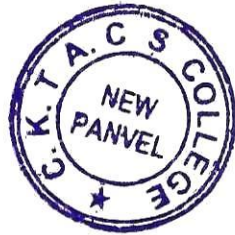


Admission Committee 2026-2027

Rules of Passing

1. A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester II irrespective of the number of courses of failure in the Semester I.
2. A learner being eligible for the admission to **Second Year Semester III** must have-
 - a. Passed in all the courses of semester I and Semester II Examinations.

OR

 - b. A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester III, if he/she earns 32 or more Cumulative credits from Semester I and Semester II.
3. A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester IV irrespective of the number of courses of failure in the Semester III.
4. A learner being eligible for the admission to **Third Year Semester V** must have-
 - a. Passed in all the courses of semester I, Semester II, Semester III and Semester IV Examinations.

OR

 - b. A learner shall be allowed to take Admission to Semester V and Keep Terms if he/she Passes in all the courses of both Semester I and Semester II and if he/she earns 32 or more Cumulative credits from Semester III and Semester IV

OR

 - c. A learner shall be allowed to take Admission to Semester V and Keep Terms if he/she Passes in all the courses of both Semester III and Semester IV and if he/she earns 32 or more Cumulative credits from Semester I and Semester II.
5. A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester VI irrespective of the number of courses of failure in the Semester V.
6. The result of Semester VI shall be withheld by the College till the learner passes all the Semesters from I – V.
7. A Learner is allowed to take admission in semester VII (UG Hon. /PG Part I) only if he passes all courses of semesters I to VI earns 132 Credits.
